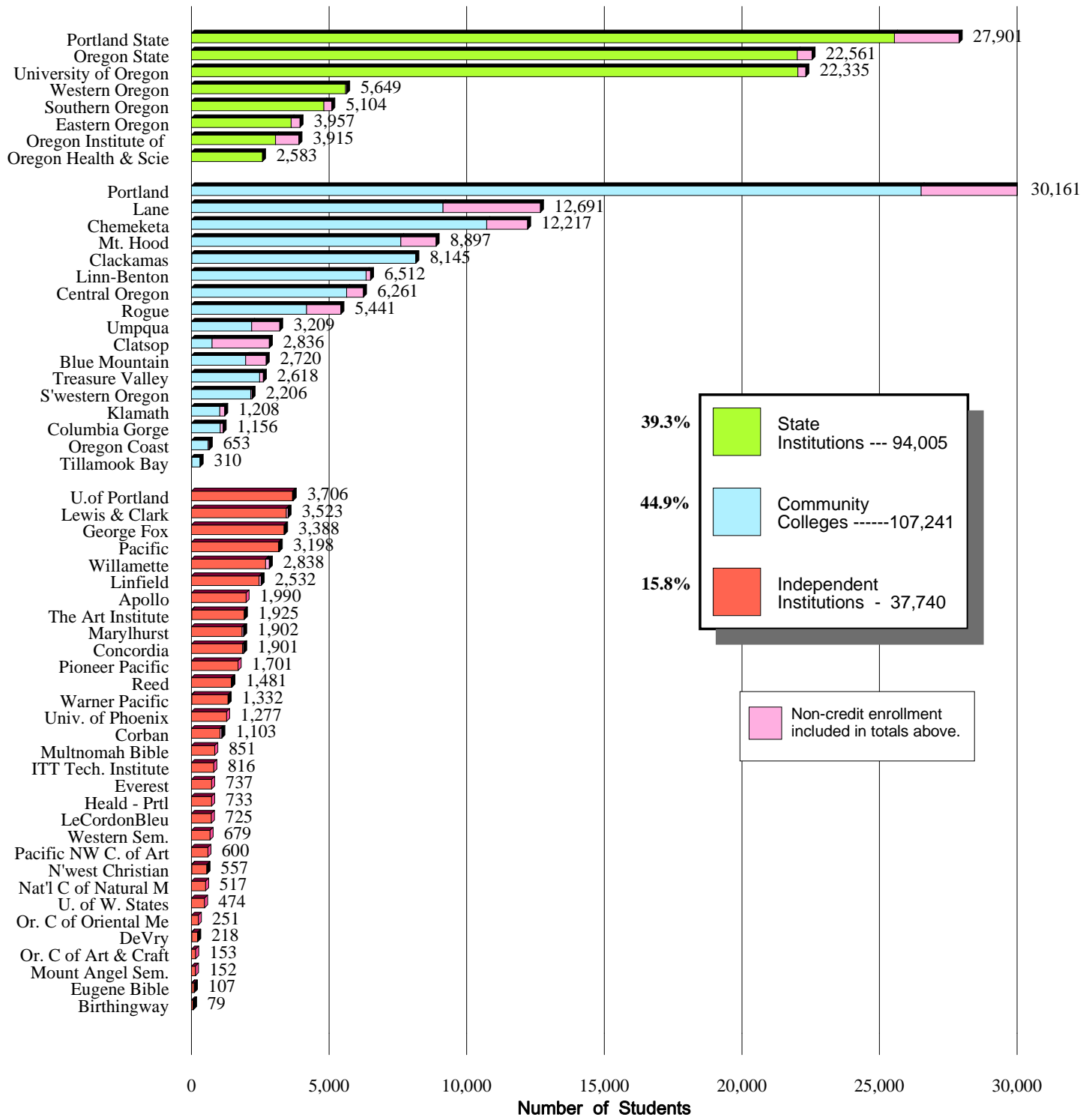

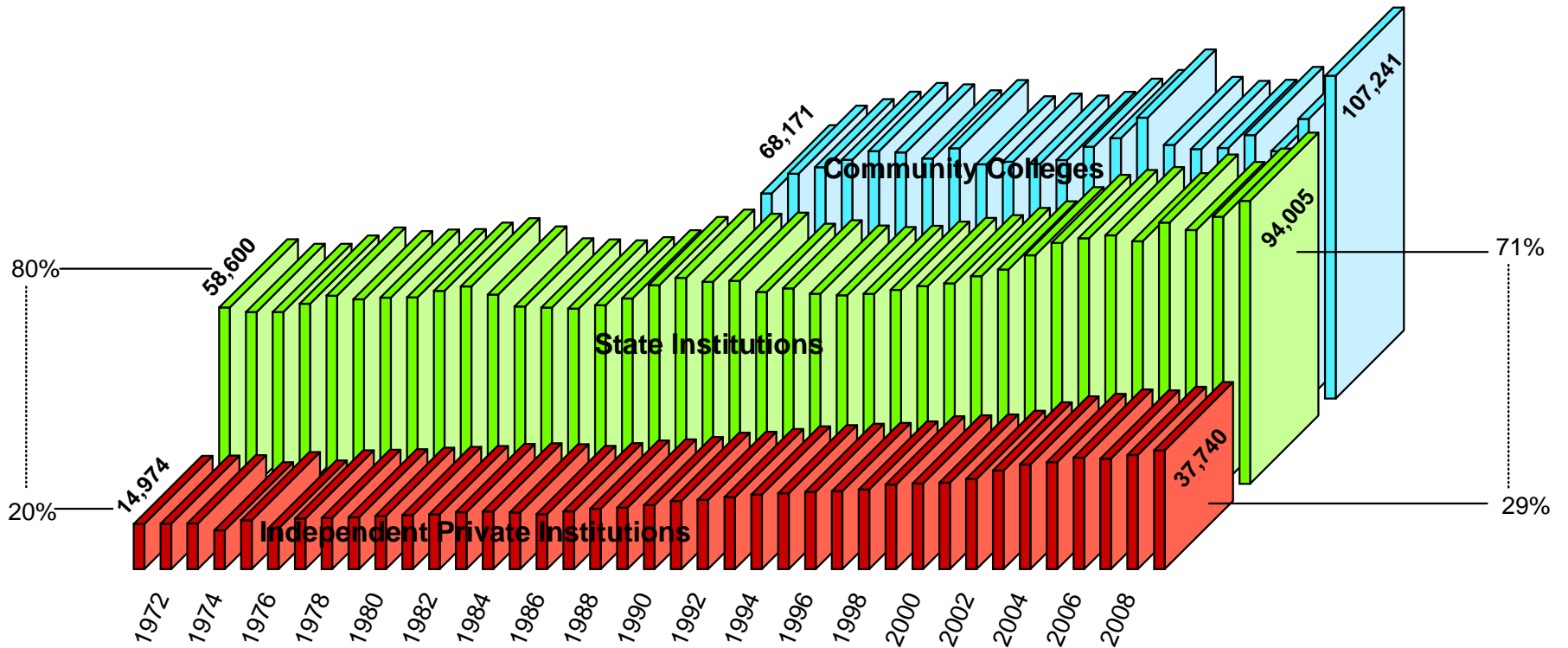
# ALL DEGREE-GRANTING OREGON INSTITUTIONS TOTAL HEADCOUNT -- FALL, 2009

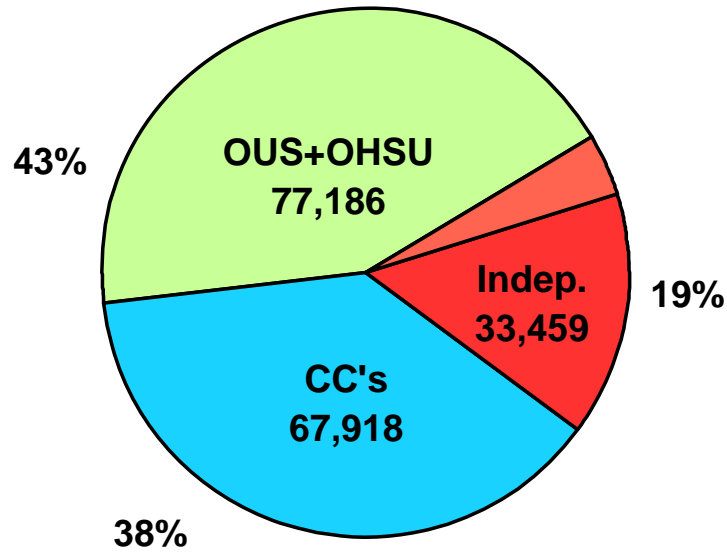

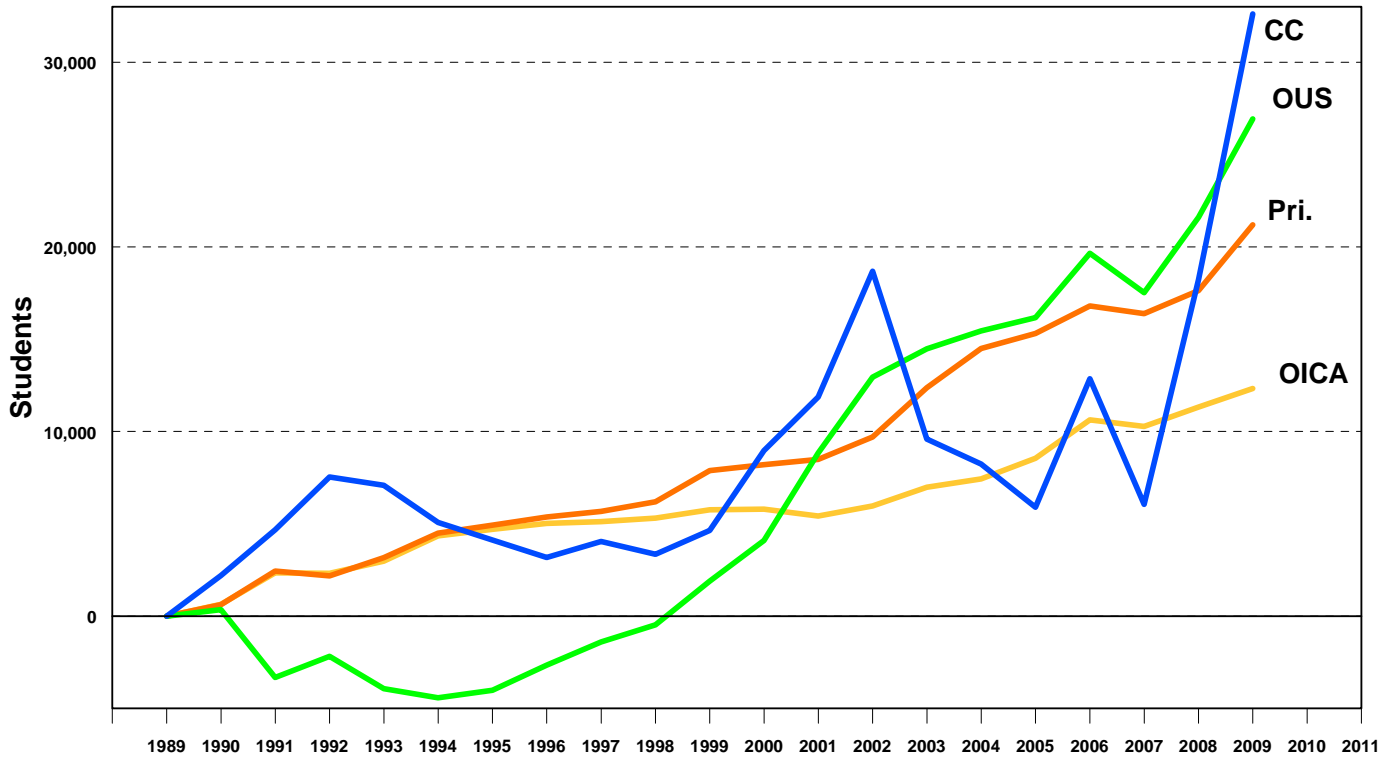

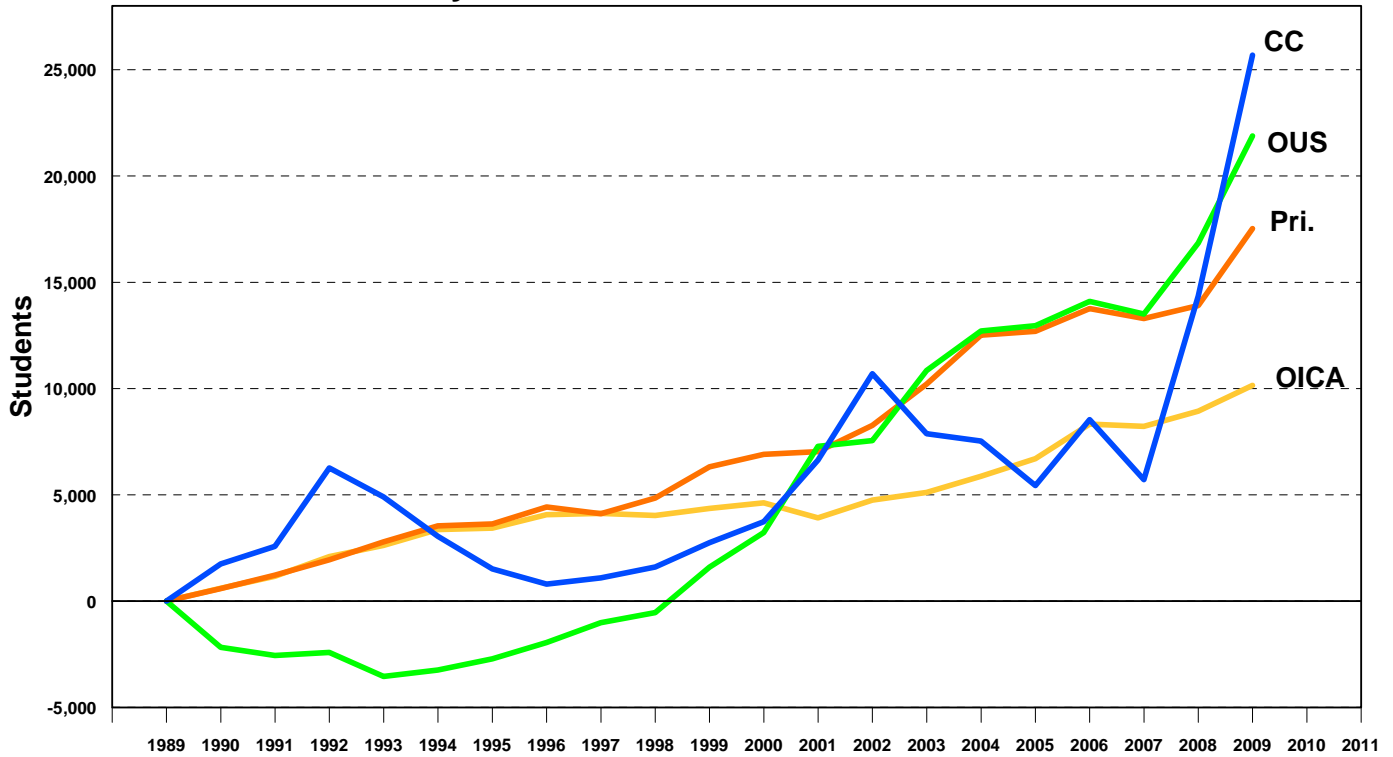

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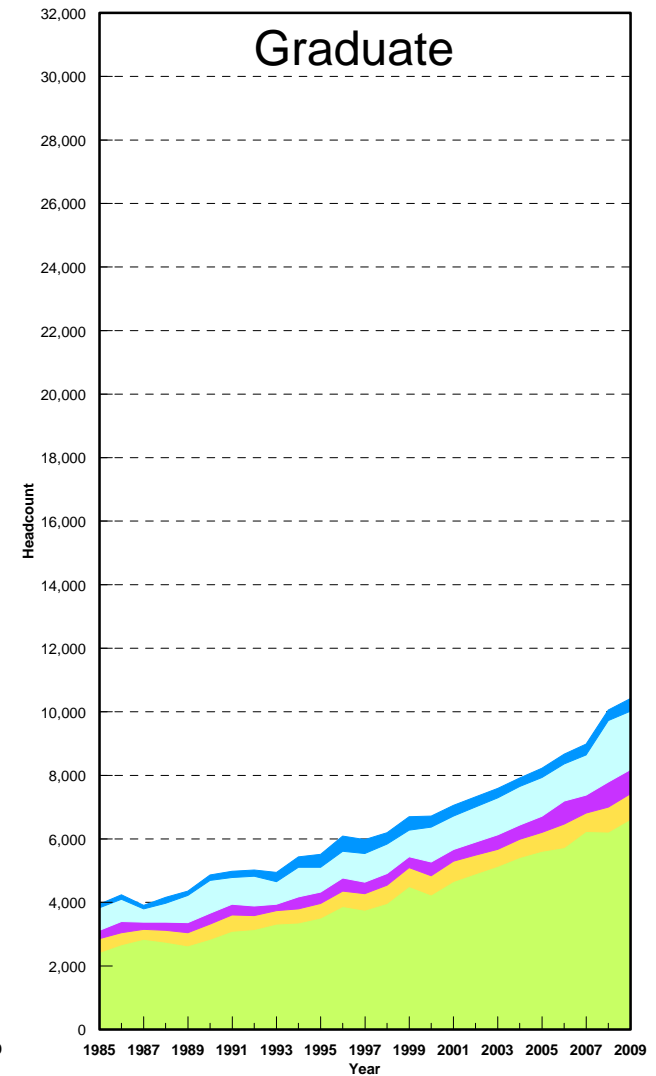
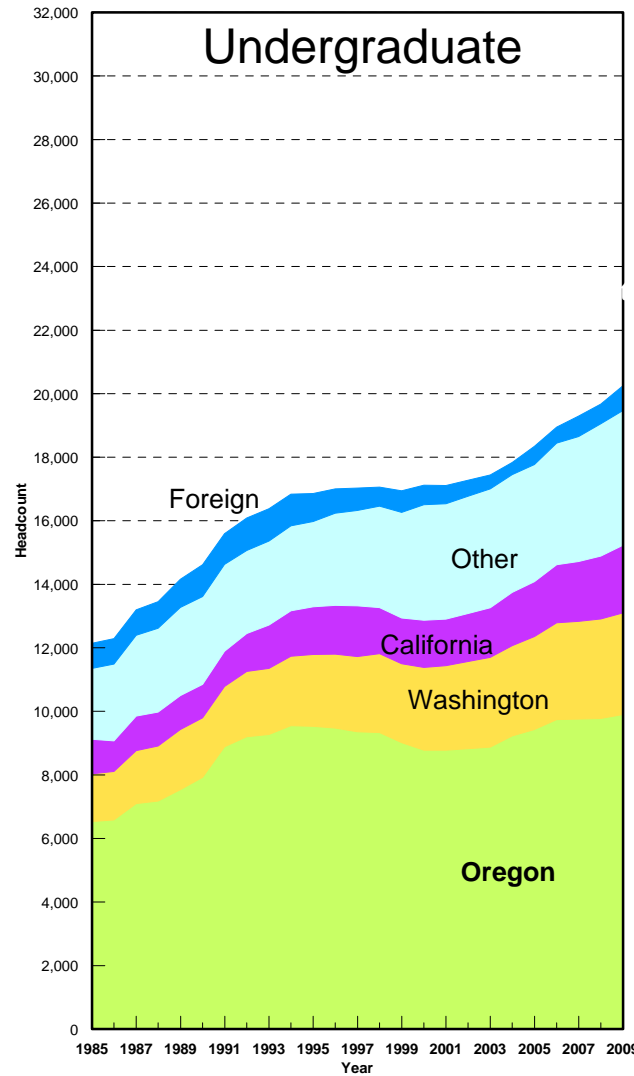
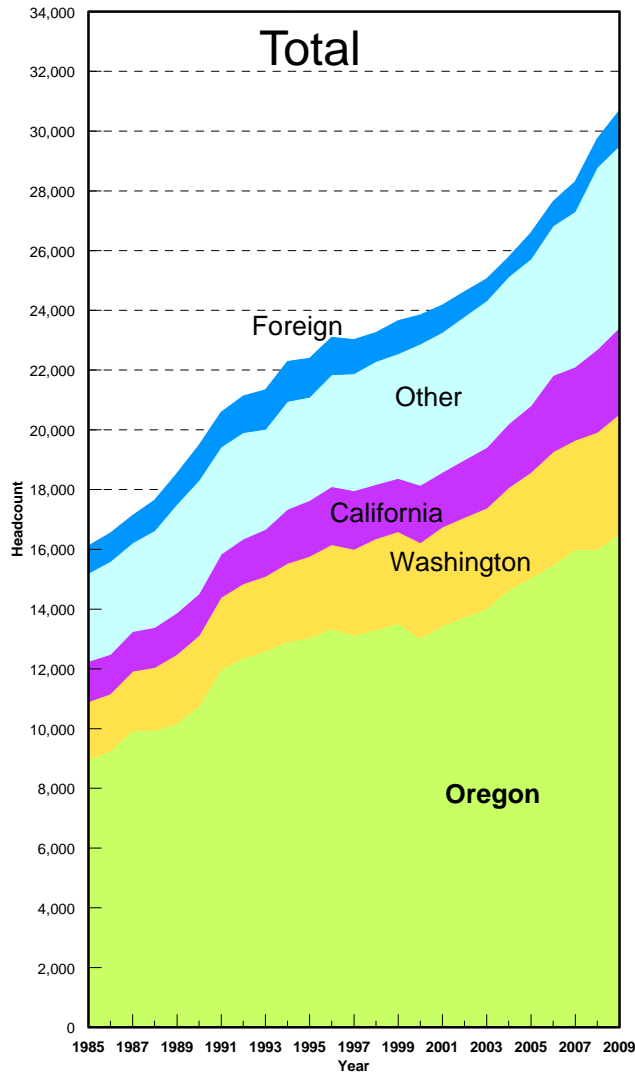

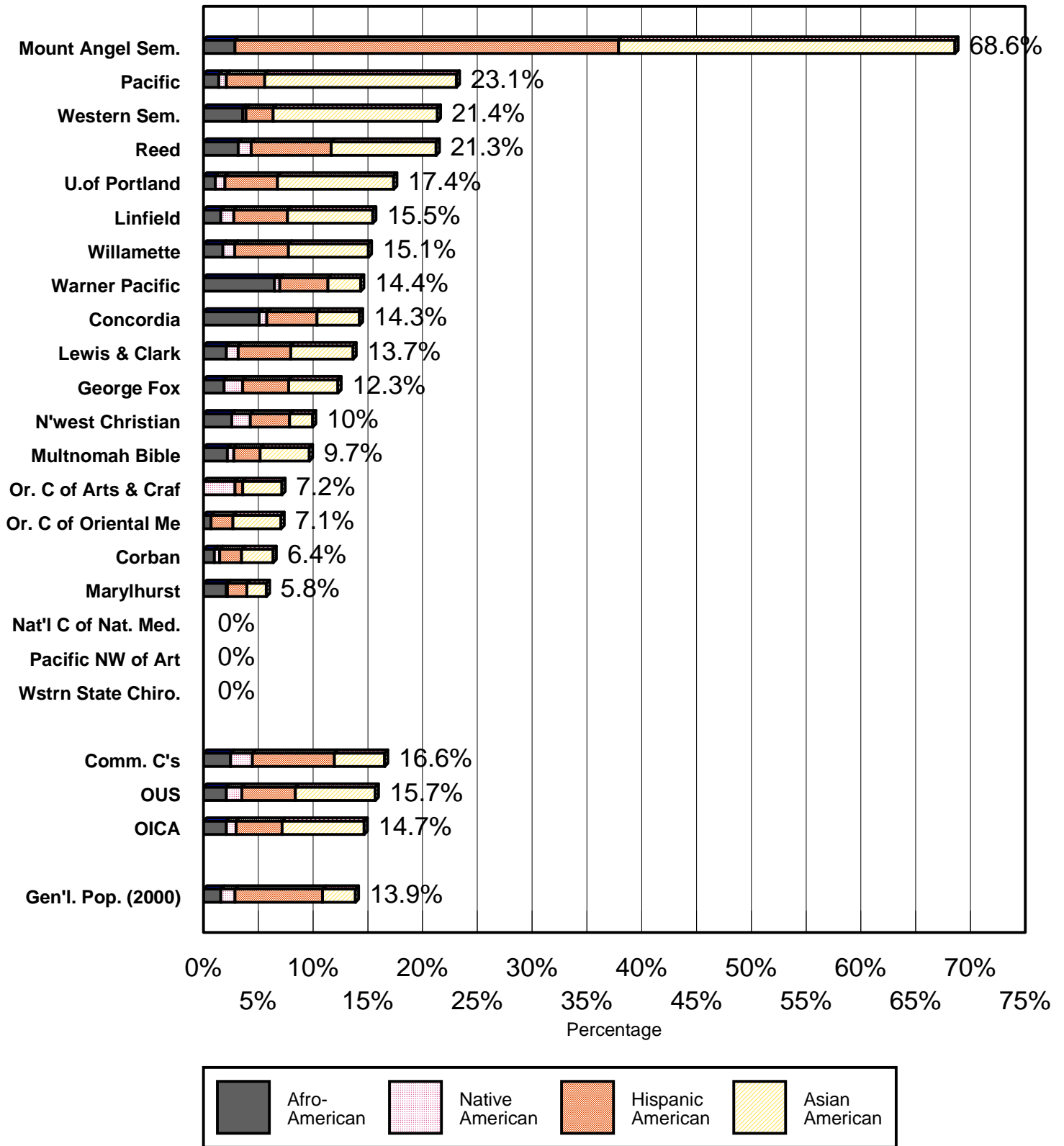

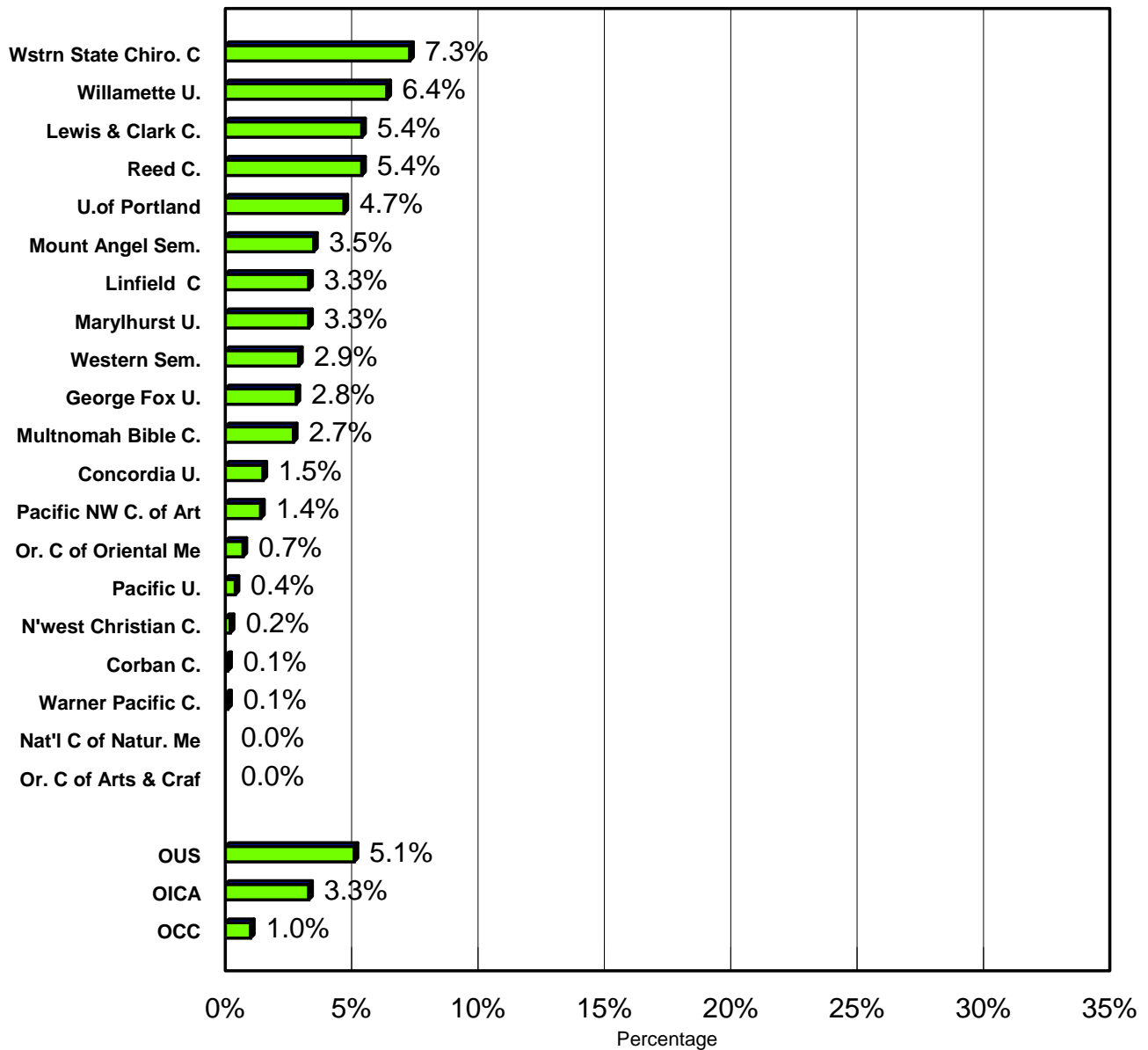
# PERCENT MINORITY STUDENTS IN OREGON HIGHER EDUCATION FALL HEADCOUNT -- 2008

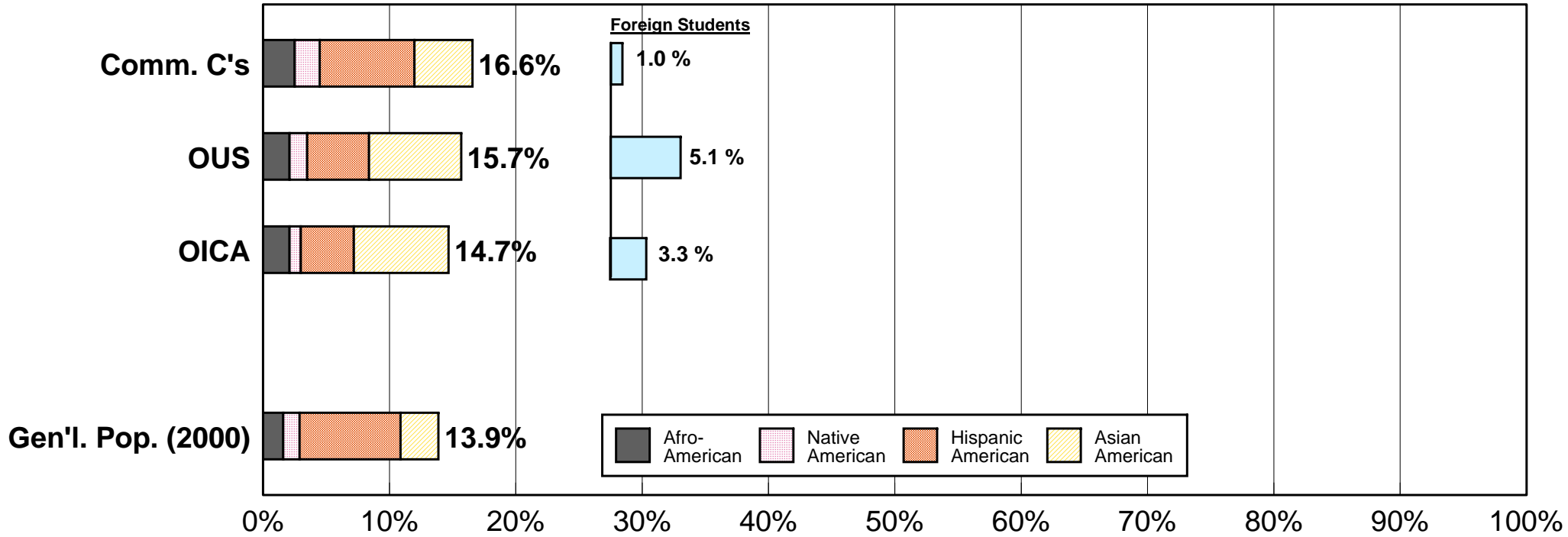

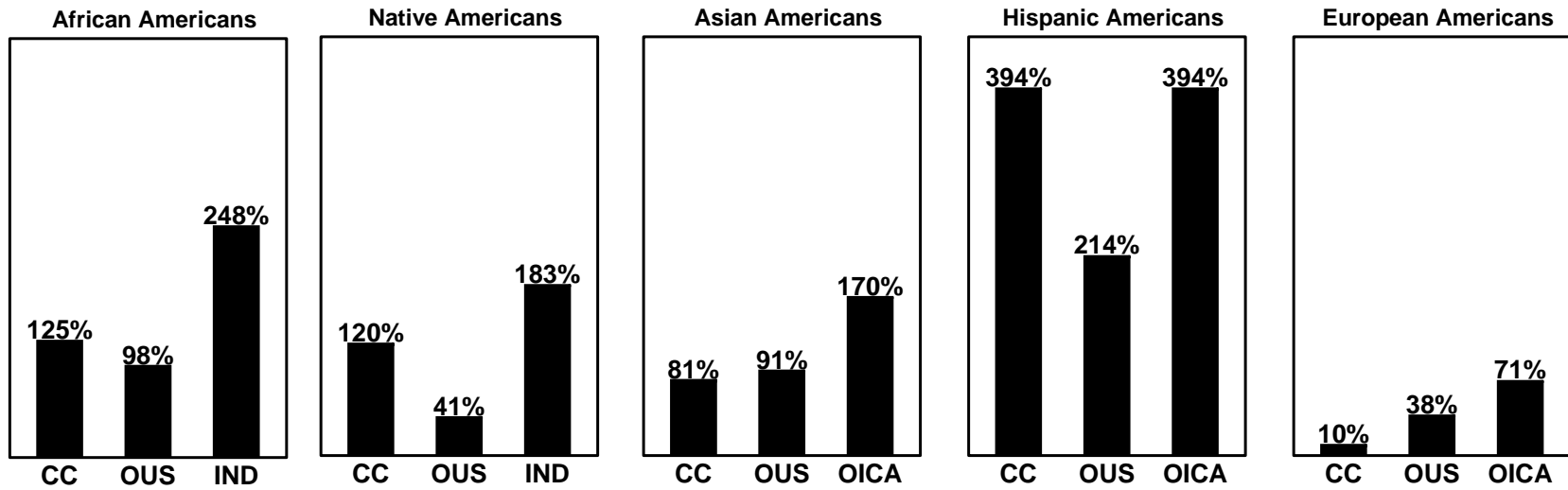
## PERCENT MINORITY STUDENTS IN OREGON HIGHER EDUCATION FALL HEADCOUNT -- 2008

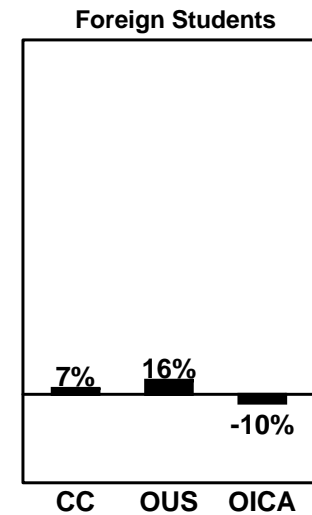

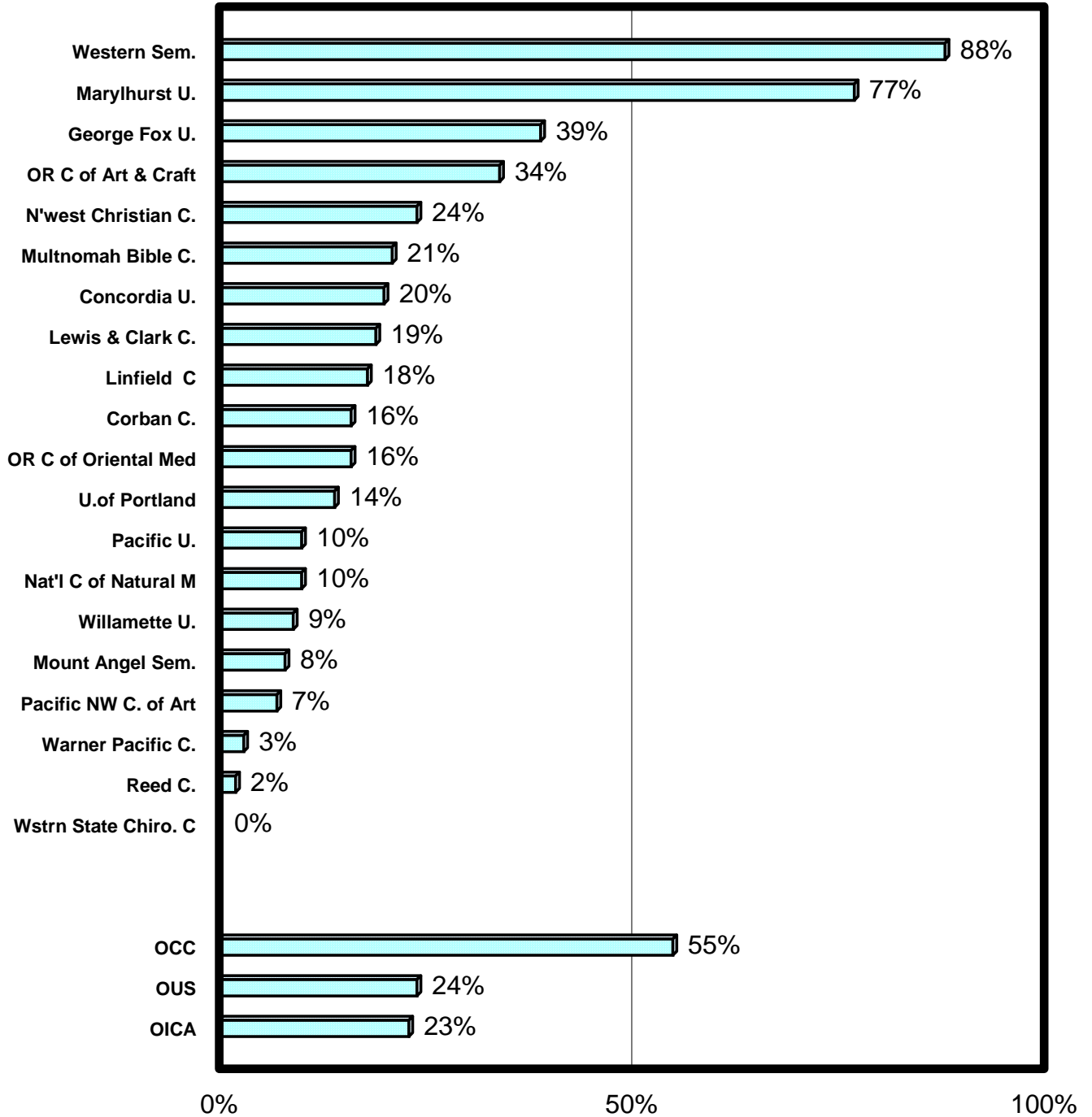

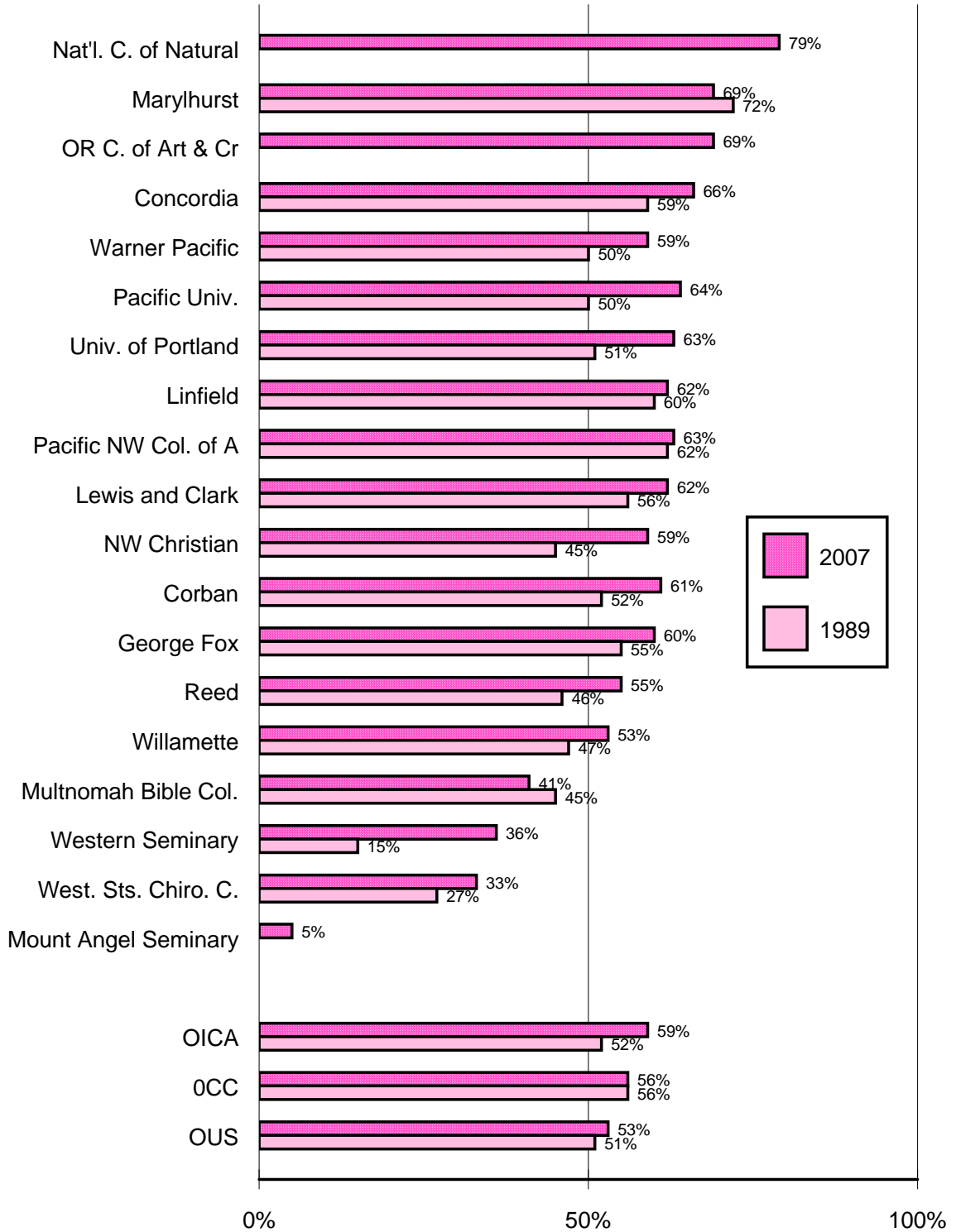
## PERCENT PART-TIME STUDENTS \* IN OREGON HIGHER EDUCATION FALL, 2008

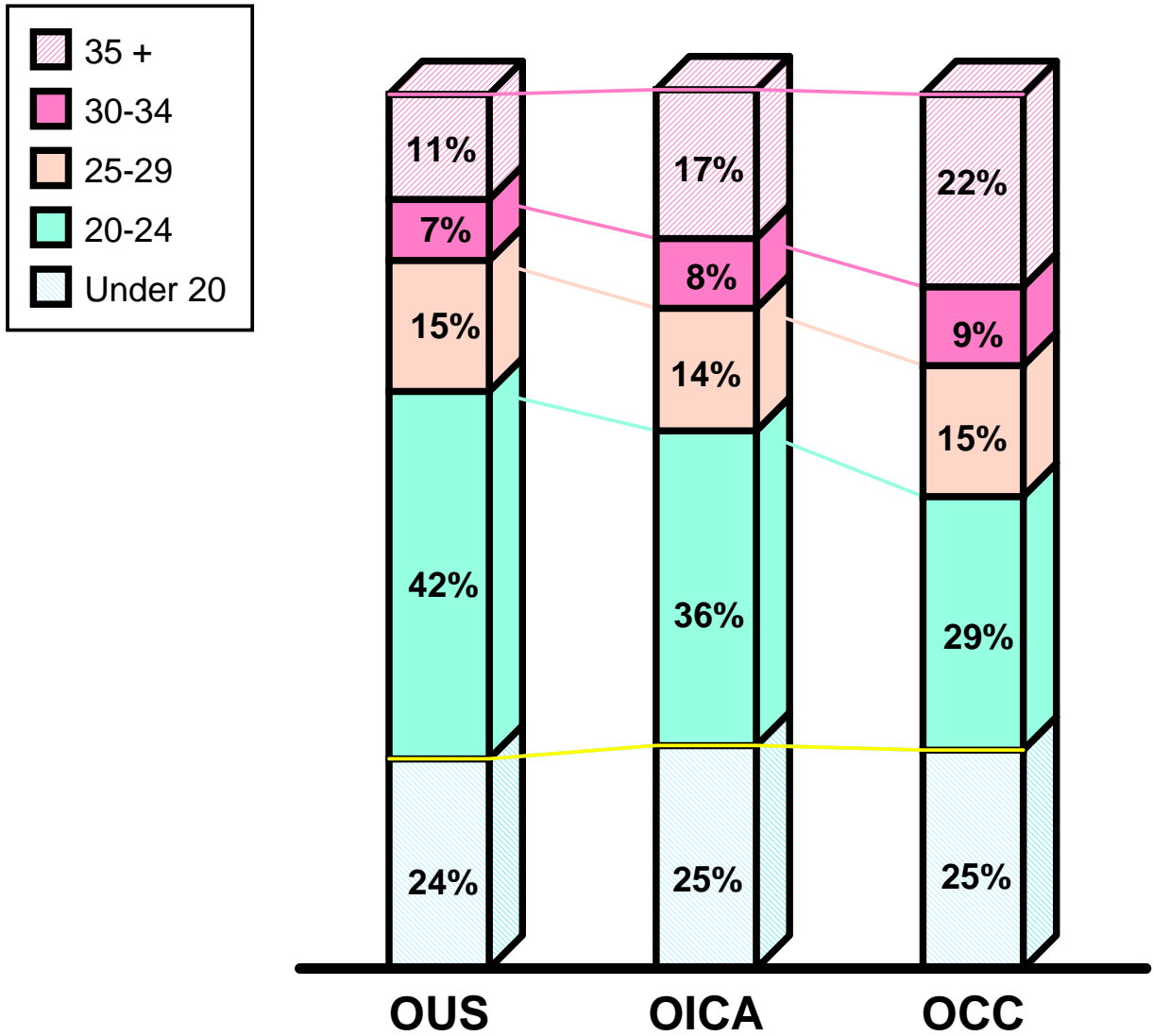

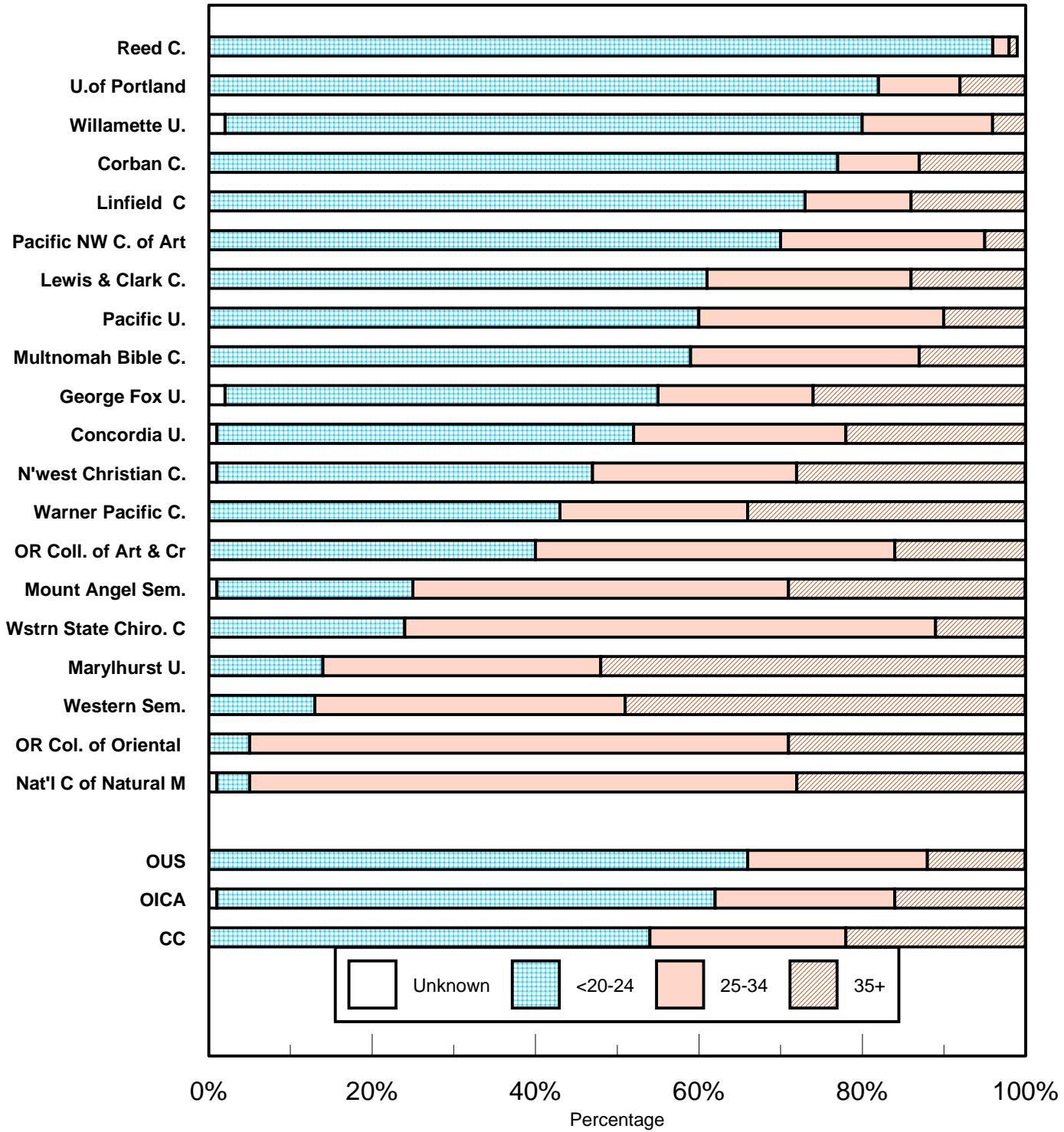

## AGE DISTRIBUTION OF STUDENTS IN OREGON HIGHER EDUCATION FALL, 2007



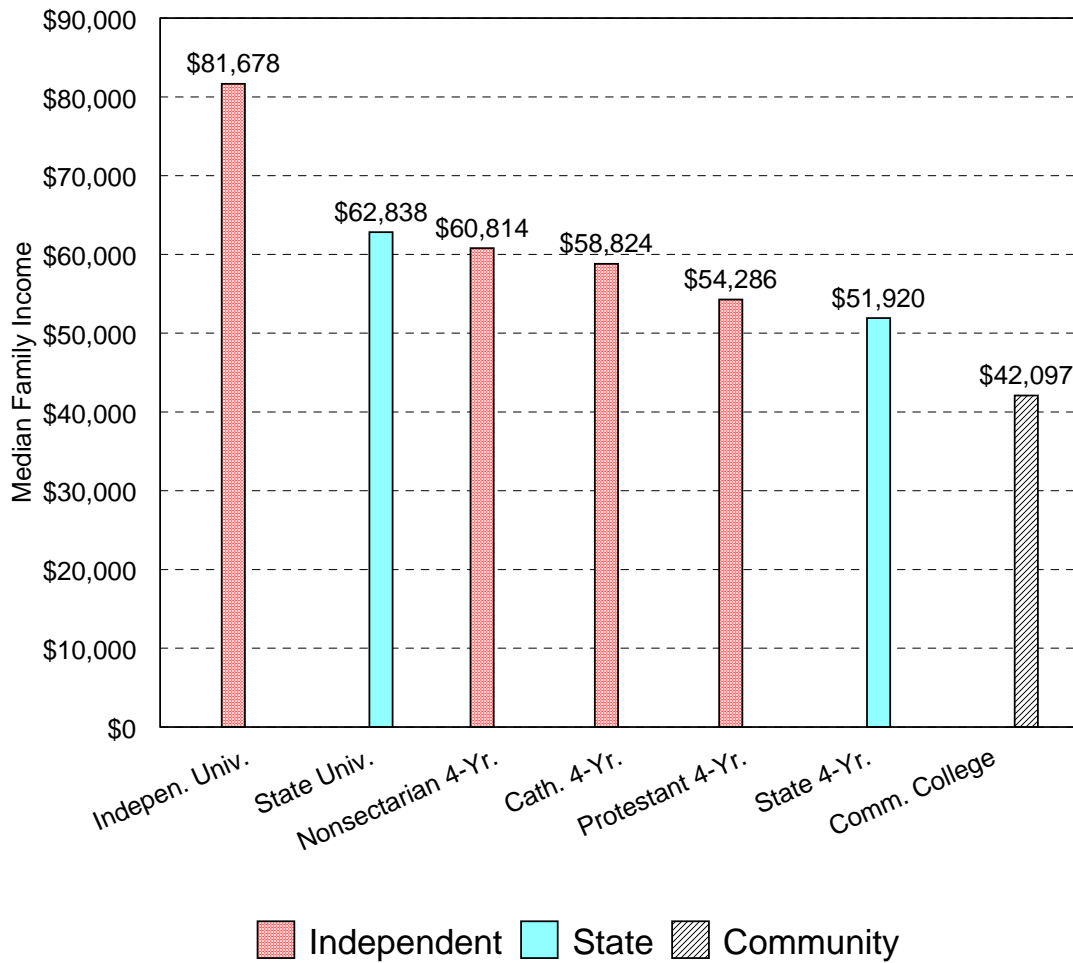

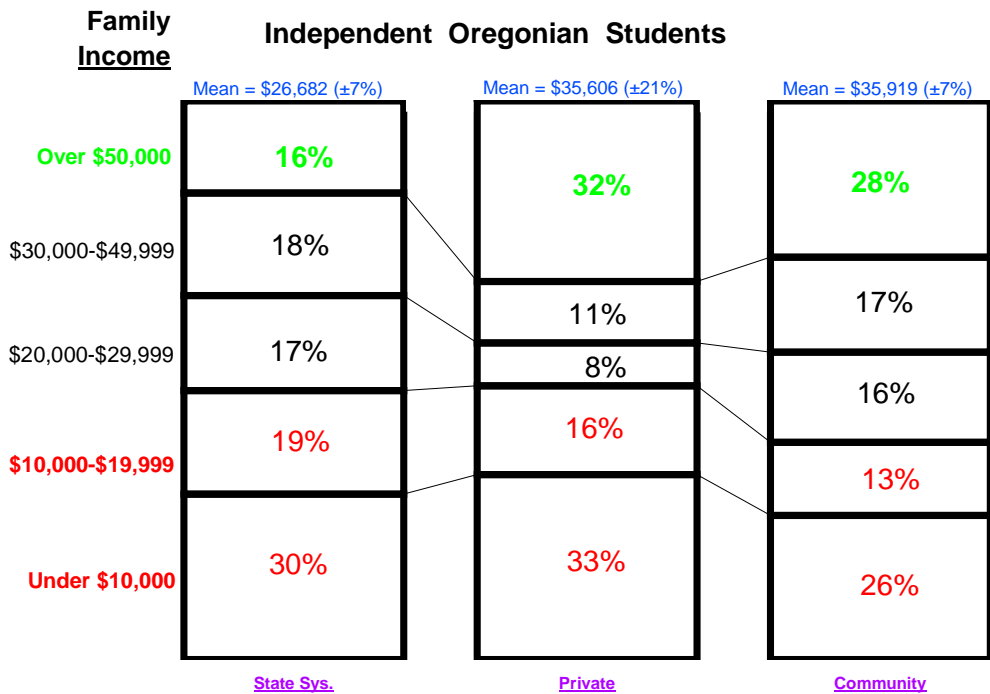
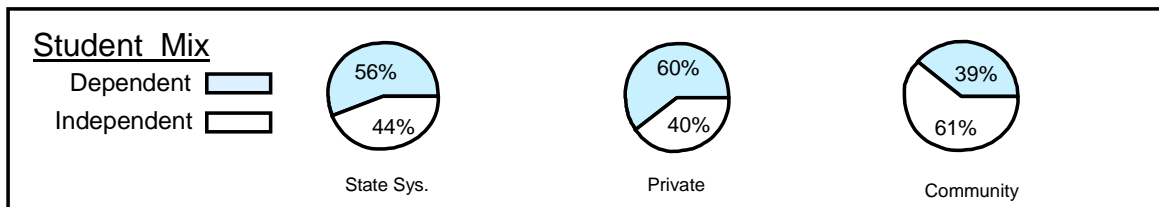
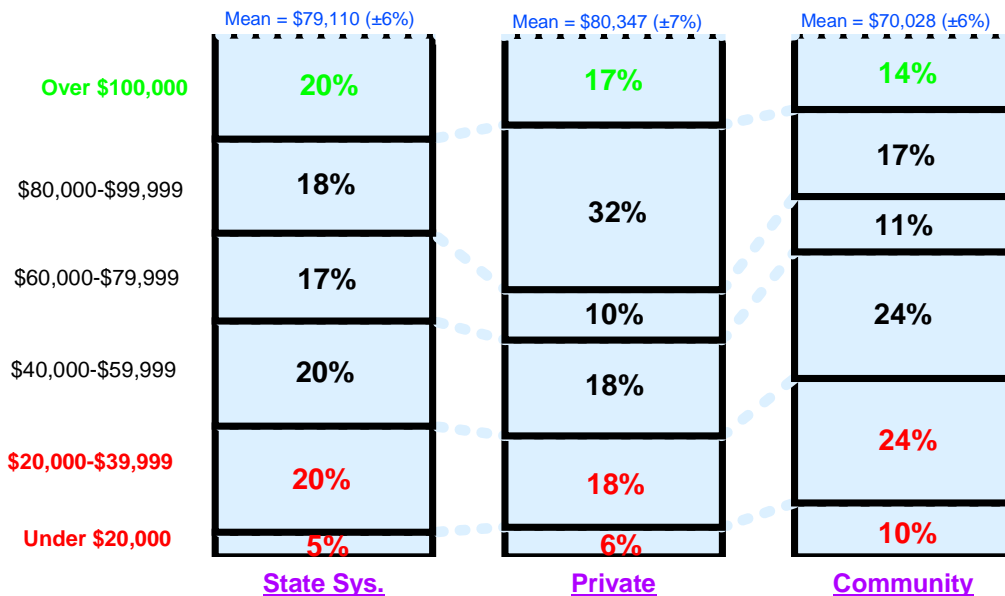
## National Median Family Income by Institutional Type and Control for 1997 Freshmen

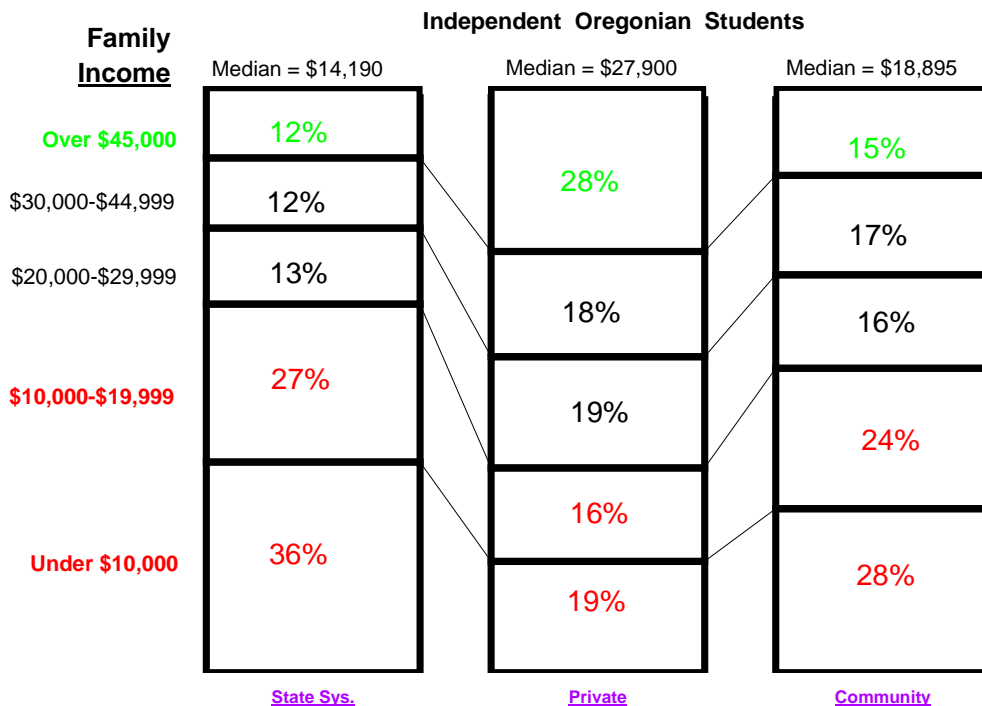
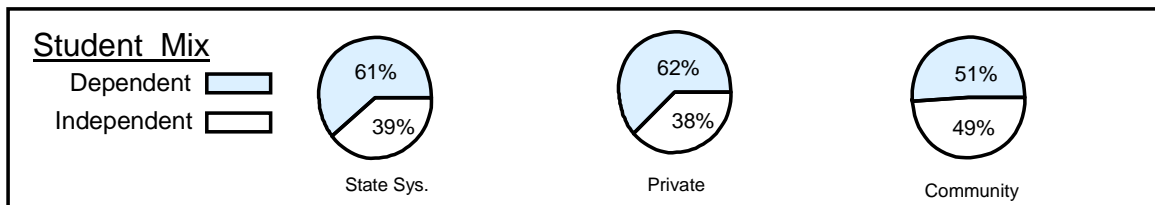
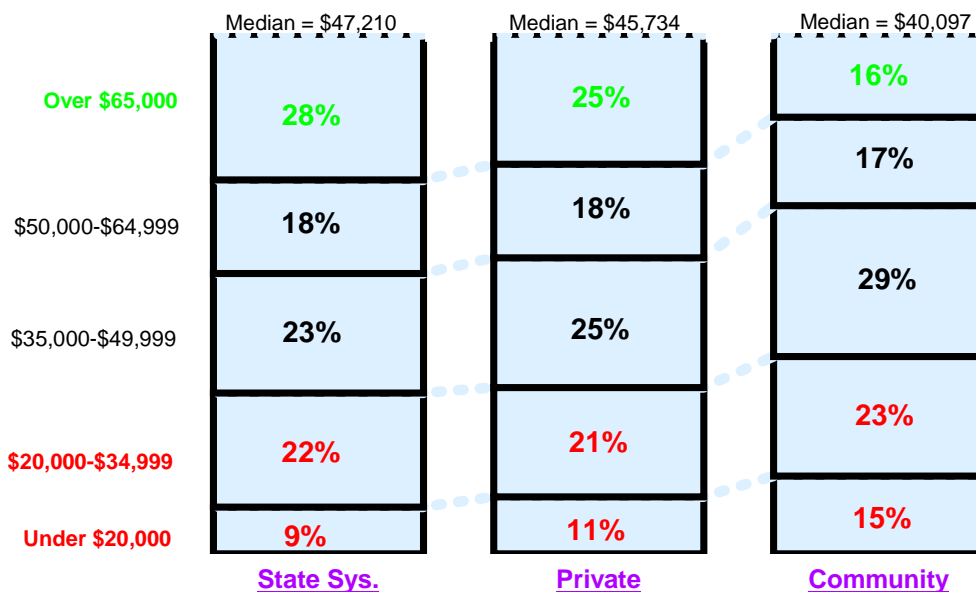

- 21 Less than half of families save for college. Savings are relatively modest and fall sharply at lower income levels.
- 22(10) Dependent family savings relative to college costs are substantial for c.c. students – actually *exceeding* c.c. costs for nearly half these students.
- 29 Cost savings for living at home *generally* range from \$2,000-5,000.

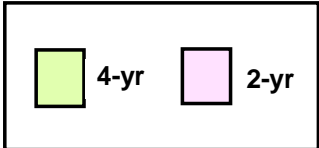

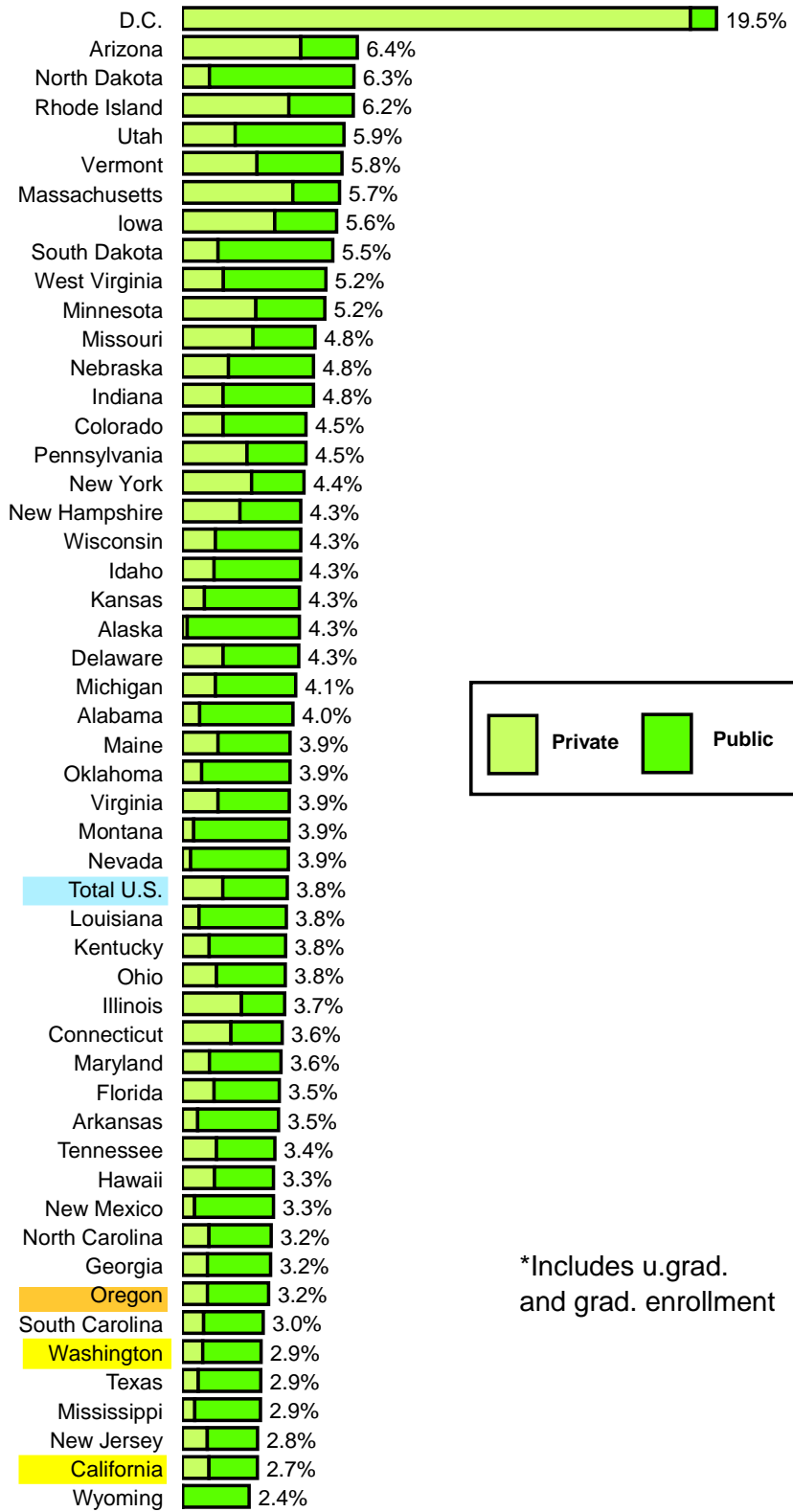

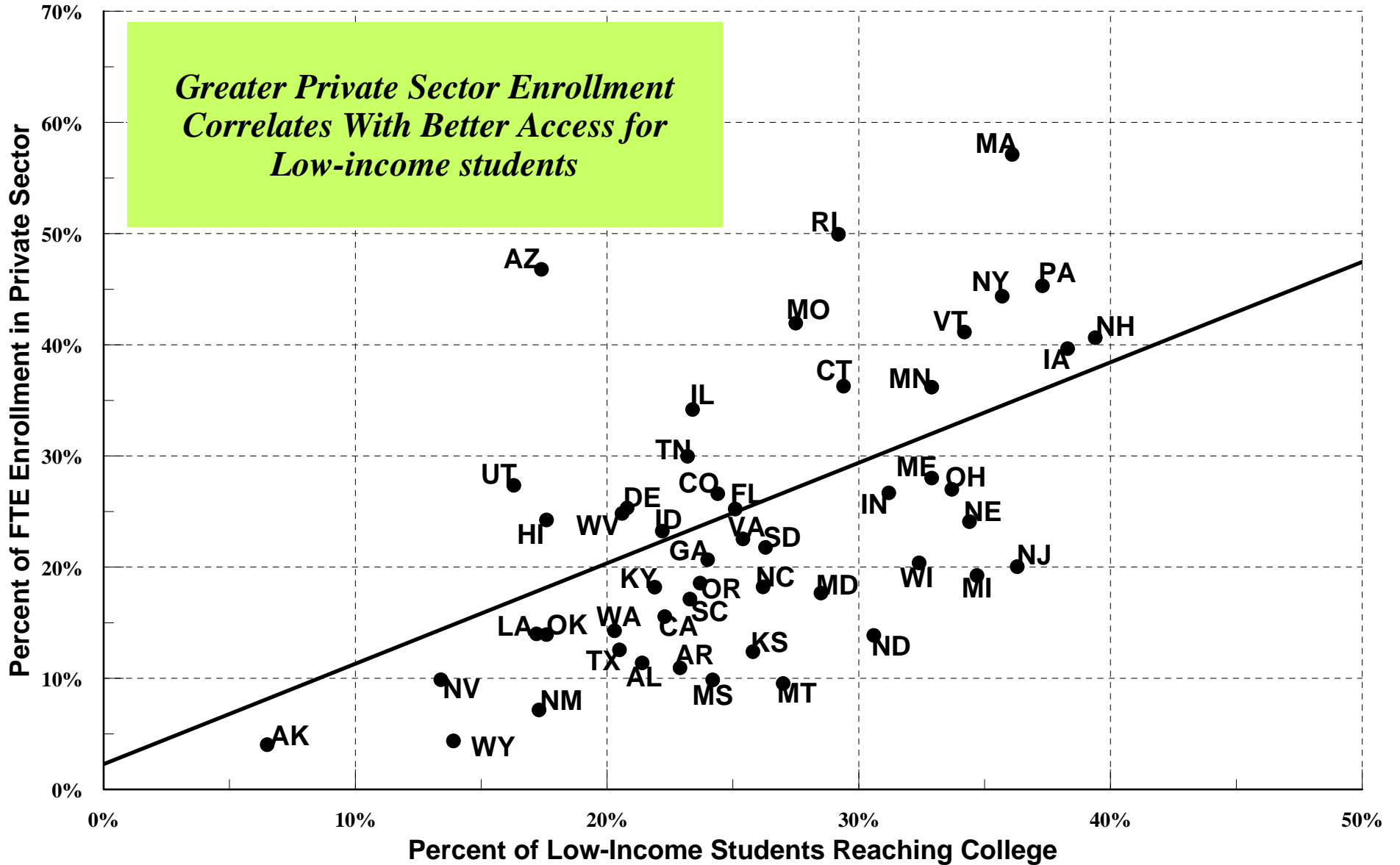
